We serve and help children and adults recovering from mental health challenges as well as people struggling with drug and alcohol related issues. Our professional team provides a full range of clinical services, including intake and referral, individual, couples, family and group counseling, comprehensive biopsychosocial evaluations, and psychotropic medication management. We also provide crisis services on a walk-in basis, which includes brief treatment and arrangements for psychiatric hospitalization if necessary.


TESTING SERVICES AT GCC

At Greenridge Counseling Center, an assessment process typically includes an initial clinical interview, 3-4 testing sessions, and a feedback session. There is a one-time fee for all assessments, which covers the entire cost of the testing process. GCC is able to keep its rates comparatively low because we are defined as a community-based mental health agency.

- All test are performed under the supervision of a **licensed psychologist**.
- **Each assessment consists of a full-battery**, not a screening. Testing is comprehensive and provides data about all areas of functioning, including academic achievement
- **Timely appointments**
- **We assess all individuals** from 12-months old to adulthood
- We address both **clinical** and **educational** concerns.



ASSESSMENT OF AUTISM SPECTRUM DISORDER



THE FACTS:

According to the Center for Disease Control (CDC), "Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) occurs in all racial, ethnic, and socioeconomic groups, but is five times more common among boys than girls. The CDC estimates that 1 in 68 children identify with ASD.

OUR STANDARDS:

To promote the accurate assessment and diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder across the lifespan, our agency utilizes the Autism Diagnostic Observation Schedule-2 (ADOS-2). The ADOS-2 is considered the "Gold Standard" of diagnosing/assessing Autism, a valid instrument for ages 12 months – adulthood. ADOS-2 is utilized in combination with self-reports from both parents and teachers for the most accurate assessment.

PSYCHO-EDUCATIONAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT SERVICES FAQ

Why would I need psycho-educational or psychological testing?

- ♦ To identify learning and cognitive concerns that may indicate a need for specialized accommodations at school and other educational settings
- ♦ To clarify diagnoses such as ADHD, learning disorders, mood/anxiety disorders, psychosis, and dementia
- ♦ To provide a clearer understanding of personality and its impact on emotional, cognitive and behavioral functioning
- ♦ To assist in educational planning and placement
- ♦ To receive a more comprehensive and clearer understanding of a child's needs, often beyond what is found in a standard school assessment

What does a full battery assessment include?

- ♦ Cognitive/Intellectual Testing
- ♦ Assessment of academic achievement
- ♦ Measures of attention, working memory and executive functioning
- ♦ Assessment of language/phonological processes
- ♦ Evaluation of non-verbal reasoning
- ♦ Assessment of information processing
- ♦ Identification of basic personality traits and styles
- ♦ Assessment of a wide range of mental health and behavioral concerns
